- **Dog kennels:** Socializing, walking dogs, basic obedience, grooming dogs, cleaning kennels, doing laundry
- **Office Helpers:** Answering phones, clerical work, adoption follow up, assist with surrender paperwork, Clean Office (AM) light cleaning (PM).
- **Fostering:** cats, kittens and dogs
- **Ground Maintenance:** Mowing lawn, weed eating, edging, planting & watering flowers, cleaning gutters.
- **Events:** Facilitate Adoption Events at participating businesses.

The clinic is open Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM
Morning and afternoon shifts available

Volunteer opportunities include:

- **Reception/Office Assistant:** talking with clients, taking payments, making reminder phone calls, filing paperwork
- **Exam Room Assistant:** assisting the veterinarian with pre-surgery examinations
- **Transfer Person:** helping move animals back and forth between the lobby and the kennels at check-in and check-out
- **Recovery Assistant:** recovering animals from surgery (including monitoring vital signs), cleaning and wrapping surgical instruments
- **Technician Assistant:** restraining patients for the Certified Veterinary Technician (CVT) during induction of anesthesia and intubation
- **Clinic Caretaker:** cleaning and disinfecting rooms, restocking supplies

Available shifts: 9:45 am to 1:15 pm or 12:45 pm to 5:15 pm

Volunteer opportunities include:

- **Customer Service:** assisting customers, answering questions about store merchandise, talking to customers on the phone.
- **Cashier:** handling money, processing cash and credit card transactions.
- **Stocking:** categorizing and placing products on the shelves, tagging items.
- **Store Caretaker:** cleaning up spills or broken items, dusting and cleaning shelves, putting misplaced items back on the right shelves, vacuuming, washing windows, decorating for holidays or other special events.
- **Donation Sorter:** verifying that items received are in good condition for customers to buy, giving receipts to and collecting information from people donating products.
- **HBPets Ambassador:** communicating our mission and activities to customers.
- **E-Commerce Sales Associate** – Photographing, researching, listing items online.
